Call to Order: Chair A. Sullivan called the regular meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Minutes: Motion by J. Moulton to approve the minutes of January 8, 2007 as presented, seconded by A. Sullivan. So voted.

Public Communication: Chris Pettibon submitted the formal architectural renderings of the town hall front façade. The Selectboard reviewed the plans and Chair Sullivan advised Mr. Pettibon that they would like to establish a committee to look at different avenues of repairing the town hall.

Road Foreman Report: Foreman advised that someone will be looking at the culvert on Lake Road to determine if a liner can be inserted to help defray expense. Cut most of the brush on Lake Road. The Board reviewed the highway grant paperwork ; talked about replacing the pressure washer (needs a new gas tank) and the Selectboard directed that it be replaced so the trucks and equipment can be kept washed. Reviewed the inspection report done on the garage by the State and the few issues addressed will be corrected in the near future. Foreman discussed the guardrails and road sinking on Panton Road by Bourgeois. It's thought that perhaps it's a situation with a fuel tank being used as a culvert but more investigation is needed. Chair Sullivan read a letter received from Charles Lowman regarding the inadequacy of the hidden drive sign by Kneeshaw's on Lake Road. The letter S was added to the existing sign but is not large enough to be noticed so therefore it is being replaced with a new sign, Hidden Drives, which will warn of Kneeshaw's hidden drive as well as Lowman's hidden drive. The Foreman advised that the State of Vermont would not allow signs for every hidden driveway and there are others in the town. The sign will be replaced when the ground thaws some. Chair Sullivan will respond to Mr. Lowman's letter.

New Business:

Motion by J. Moulton to move the monthly Selectboard meetings from the second Monday of the month to the second Tuesday of the month, seconded by A. Sullivan. So voted.

Motion by J. Moulton to accept the resignation of Ron Atkins from the Selectboard, seconded by A. Sullivan. So voted.

Old Business:

J. Moulton to check with the DRB on the Zoning Regulations as the Selectboard did not have a chance to formalize the approval and review process.

Action Items:

Check warrants were signed, correspondence reviewed and the contract with Addison County Humane Society was reviewed and signed.

Chair Sullivan adjourned the meeting at 9:15 p.m.
