The meeting was reconvened from Monday, March 25, 2008 at 4:00 p.m.

Martha Price from District #5 Agency of Transportation gave the Board an overview of the grants available and the requirements for each.

After a brief question and answer session, the board agreed that a structure grant to replace the large culvert on Lake Road should be the priority for 2008-2009. Road resurfacing will not be done this year and Ms. Price agreed it may be better to wait until next year considering we received a grant in 2007. It was discussed that Jersey Street south was in great need of work and R. Cloutier is working with Addison on the possibility of upgrading Jersey Street from a Class 3 to a Class 2 which will enable Panton to apply for a highway grant.

Discussed the trees being removed on Panton Road (at the edge of Vorsteveld's field) as well as the discharge from field drainage.

R. LaFleche recessed the meeting to Monday, March 31st which will be a working session to prepare the structure grant. Meeting recessed at 4:50 p.m.
