An emergency Selectboard meeting was called by John Viskup to discuss highway overtime and budget issues. John expressed concern that the highway department is still charging the town for overtime against the directive of the Board (refer to minutes of 12/8/08 & 12/17/08). Rejean commented that he didn't agree with zero overtime and a discussion ensued that with two highway people overtime shouldn't be necessary. John also commented that he noticed that grader being used to push back snow along the road edges and he doesn't want it used for that. He added that the tandem should be able to do the same job. Rejean explained that most towns utilized their graders for this type of job. John expressed concern that this puts a burden on our old and overused grader. Rejean asked that John be in charge of the highway personnel and John accepted. Rejean explained that he was not going to continue his term on the Selectboard and would be tendering his resignation effective immediately. Discussion on not using snow fence and reducing the budget thereof. It was again agreed that no overtime is to be used.
