Call to Order: Chair Lynn Donnelly reconvened the meeting from July 14, 2009 at 11:00 a.m.

Review of Budget/Tax Information: Balance sheet for year ended June 2009 and statement of taxes were reviewed. Motion by John Viskup, seconded by Beth Tarallo to approve a municipal tax rate of \$.5972. It was noted that the education rate for residential is \$1.5501 and non-residential \$1.6091 as set by the State of Vermont Tax Department.

Stimulus Package: Discussion on the importance of applying for the second round of stimulus money for town hall repair. Lynn will write a letter-of-intent draft and Beth will prepare a timeline for application requirements.

General: John Viskup advised that David Chase has been maintaining the park across from the Panton store for quite some time spending his own money for upkeep etc. Discussion ensued on who owns the property and Lynn remarked that she believes it belongs to Lowensteins. John commented that the Junipers located along the park were dead and needed to be taken out. Lynn offered to speak with Dennis Mueller regarding ownership of the park. She will also speak to the owner of Dock Doctors about a dock at Arnold Bay boat access.
