Minutes of Annual Meeting  
March 4, 2006

Ann Sullivan called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

ARTICLE 1. To elect the following officers.

- a) Moderator – Ann Sullivan was nominated by Ann Russett. Jan Moulton made the motion for the Clerk to cast one ballot for Ann Sullivan, seconded by Bill Polk. Motion passed on a voice vote.
- b) Clerk – Susan Torrey was nominated by Corrie Palmer. James Dayton made the motion for the Clerk to cast one ballot for Susan Torrey seconded by Dr. Luginbuhl. Motion passed on a voice vote.

ARTICLE 2. To hear the report of the Panton Town School District officers and take action thereon.

Moved and seconded to accept and adopt the Town Officer's Report. Motion carried by voice vote.

ARTICLE 3. To elect one director to the Panton Town School District Board for a term of three (3) years.

Teresa Smith nominated Kirsten Vorsteveld. Corrie Palmer made the motion for the Clerk to case one ballot for Teresa Smith. Motion carried by voice vote.

ARTICLE 4. To elect one director to the Vergennes Union Elementary School District #44 Board for a term of three (3) years.

Andrew Smith was nominated by Dennis Mueller. Vi Luginbuhl moved that the Clerk cast one ballot for Andrew Smith. Motion carried by voice vote.

ARTICLE 5. To elect one director to the Vergennes Union High School District #5 Board for a term of three (3) years.

Teresa Smith was nominated by James Dayton. Corrie Palmer moved the motion and Steve Hofmann seconded. Motion carried by voice vote.

ARTICLE 6. Shall the voters of the Panton Town School District approve the sum of **\$55,222.00** to defray current expenses for the ensuing year and pay outstanding orders and obligations?

Motion moved and seconded. Carried by voice vote.

ARTICLE 7. Shall the voters of the Panton School District authorize the Board of Directors to borrow money in anticipation of taxes, by the issuance of its notes and orders payable not later than one (1) year from date for the purpose of paying the sum approved by the voters?

Motion made by Bill Polk and seconded by Dr. Luginbuhl to approve the Article as written. Motion passed on a voice vote.

ARTICLE 8. To transact any other business proper to come before said meeting.

Motion to adjourn the meeting by Bill Polk and Ed Smith seconded the motion. Motion passed on a voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
