The Town of Panton Selectboard hereby provides notice pursuant to 24 VSA s1972(a)(1) that it has adopted, at a public meeting called for that purpose on August 12, 2019, the Town of Panton Use of Public Right-of-Way Ordinance.

The Ordinance generally requires the issuance of, and sets for the terms under which, Access Permits and Obstruction/Digging/Utility Permits

will be considered, issued and enforced within the Town of Panton's rights-of-ways and town highways.

UNLESS A PETITION FOR A VOTE ON THE QUESTION OF DISAPPROVING THE ORDINANCE SIGNED BY NOT LESS THAN 5% OF QUALIFIED PANTON VOTERS

IS PRESENTED TO THE PANTON TOWN CLERK OR SELECTBOARD WITHIN 44 DAYS FOLLOWING THE DATE OF ADOPTION.
